



APPLICATIONS FOR 2018 SESSION BEING ACCEPTED

Seats remain for 2018 New York State Superintendent Development Program which opens January 19, 2018 and continues until November 3, 2018. SUNY-Oswego and the Greater Southern Tier BOCES are pleased to accept applications until the 2018 cohort is filled to allow interested school leaders time to submit application materials.

The SDP, in existence since 1998, is designed for those wishing to become superintendent of schools as well as for school leaders seeking to acquire a true district-wide perspective on K-12 education. To date, approximately 175 program graduates have moved on to become school superintendents in New York State.

Program participants ("Associates") work in regional teams facilitated by practicing superintendent members of the SDP faculty. Our faculty members are held in high regard regionally and statewide and are deeply committed to serving the next generation of superintendents.

Weekly meetings with program faculty anchor the program as Associates work to acculturate to the superintendency through a challenging series of authentic learning activities. The intent of the program is to immerse participants in the issues that superintendents confront from the reality of the superintendent position rather than from a theoretical perspective. As part of this authentic learning, participants have on-going access to current district-level issues and superintendents in their region.
